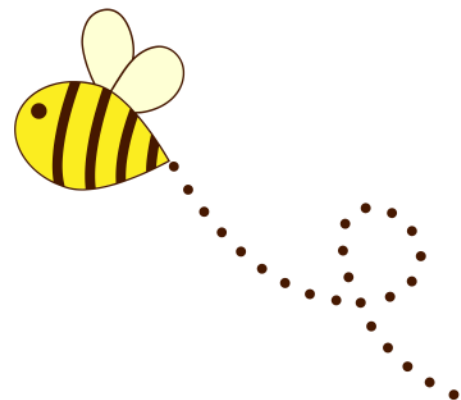


# Spring Garden Checklist

page 1

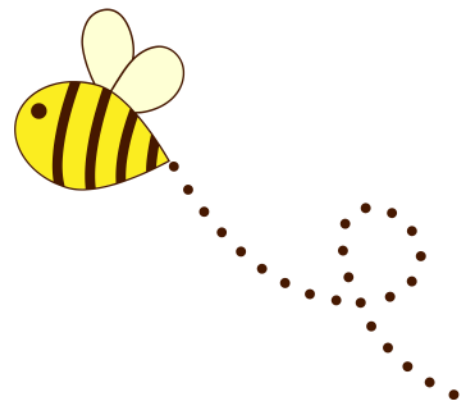
- inspect garden for damage
- use garden journal to reflect and plan
- make a list of new flowers and veggies to try
- organize seeds and order new
- place order for new soil
- book landscaping help if applicable
- sketch vegetable garden layout and rotate crops
- visit nurseries and gardens for inspiration
- remove mulch from perennials
- prune trees and shrubs
- prune fruit trees (see blog for details on timing)
- remove and clean up dead/damaged tree limbs
- reseed patchy lawn spots
- divide perennials
- stake perennials as needed



# Spring Garden Checklist

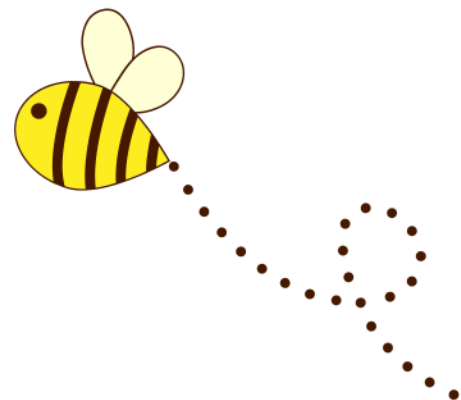
- remove old growth from perennials
- cut back ornamental grasses
- prune herbs
- check for damage on raised beds
- clean birds feeders and bird baths
- inspect window boxes and amend soil
- turn garden soil and add aged manure, compost
- plant cool season crops according to your zone
- amend flower beds with compost
- transition plants outside
- plant spring bulbs
- plan seed starting and order supplies
- weed garden beds
- edge grass
- apply mulch or bark dust to beds



# Spring Garden Checklist

page 3

- add slow release fertilizers
- order bird netting to protect berry bushes
- stock up on sluggo
- inspect fencing
- plan to rotate crops
- plant bug repelling plants
- purchase and release ladybugs as weather allows
- uncover and set up outdoor furniture
- clean off and pressure wash patio and deck
- set out spring and summer garden decorations
- inventory garden tools and replace as needed
- sharpen garden shears and clippers
- test hoses and nozzles + replace any broken
- Set up rain barrel
- Have lawn mower blades sharpened





# Spring Garden Checklist

page 4

- clean gutters
- Inspect roof for moss + book cleaning
- inspect air vents around home for damage
- touch up house paint as needed
- inspect exterior of home for winter damage
